



Framing the Challenge

Why Agile Must Evolve

Agile Was Built for Humans

What happens when your "team members" don't eat, sleep, or make typo's?



Al Meeting Summarizers: (Otter.ai, Fireflies, MS Co-Pilot)

During sprint reviews or stand-ups, AI records notes and auto-generates summaries, tasks, and decisions.



Al Assisted Code & Coding Reviews: (GitHub, MS Co-Pilot)

Developers type in user stories, or function descriptions, co-pilot auto completes the code



AI in Sprint-Planning: (Jira Advanced Roadmaps)

PM exports the backlog into ChatGPT and asks, "Group these stories into 2-week Sprints based on dependencies and story points."



Al Bots - Automation: (Leonardo, Rovo)

Automation of repetitive tasks, leading to increased efficiency and cost savings. They provide 24/7 availability and instant responses for customer service, while also freeing up human employees to focus on more complex issues.."

Orchestration:

It's no longer about just about "schedules and scope."

4 Ways Al is Transforming Agile Practices

Al Is Not Replacing Agile, It's Accelerating It!

1. Sprint Planning is becoming Predictive

Traditionally, sprint planning was more adaptive and exploratory—teams estimated work based on intuition and discussion. Now, with tools and analytics (like velocity tracking, cycle time, and burndown data), planning is becoming more data-driven and predictable.

2. Testing is Continuous

Instead of waiting until after coding is done, teams test early and often — during development, integration, and deployment — using automation and continuous integration tools.

3. Coding is Assisted

Developers now get help from intelligent tools—like Al-powered code suggestions, auto-completion, and error detection—while writing code. These tools speed up development, reduce mistakes, and improve code quality by suggesting syntax, generating snippets, or even explaining and optimizing code in real time.

4. Retrospectives are increasingly data driven

Teams now use real project data—like velocity, defect rates, cycle times, and customer feedback—during retrospectives instead of relying only on opinions or memory.

By analyzing these metrics, teams can identify patterns, make objective improvements, and measure progress over time, making retrospectives more fact-based and actionable.






Al Learns From Data, and Data Is Not Neutral
